



ABOUT THE LANDING:

The Landing is located in the Bay of Islands in the far north of New Zealand. The property comprises a thousand acres: six private beaches, an award-winning vineyard, lush wetlands, and four extraordinary Residences. The magic of the Landing lies in the experiences on offer, including bespoke, garden-to-plate dining and world-class fishing and diving, all hosted by our warm, attentive local staff. Each stay is catered to the individual and can be as restful or as active as desired.

TRANSPORTATION:

The Landing is a 55-minute helicopter flight or a four-hour drive from Auckland City. From Auckland International Airport, access is via a 35-minute scheduled flight and 30 minute drive.

THE FOUR RESIDENCES:

The Landing boasts four exceptional Residences of varying size, which all feature contemporary New Zealand art, exquisite neutral tones and luxury furnishings. Each Residence has its own private grounds and also allows guests access to The Landing’s entire property and private beaches.

The Residences are as follows:

- Cooper Residence: five bedrooms (sleeps maximum 12)
(Cooper Residence accommodation rates include The Landing personal chef and provisions)
- Gabriel Residence: four bedrooms (sleeps maximum eight)
- Vineyard Villa: three bedrooms (sleeps maximum six)
- The Boathouse: two bedrooms (sleeps maximum four).

PERSONAL CHEF:

The Landing offers a number of catering options for guests, ranging from self-catering to exclusive use of the property’s private chef, who will custom-design menus specifically to suit their needs. A garden-to-plate philosophy means The Landing’s own fruit, vegetables, honey and eggs are used alongside locally caught fish and other produce farmed and made nearby.



WINE:

The Landing's on-site vineyard can be toured and the award-winning Landing wines are made available to guests of The Residences at no additional cost. Complimentary wine tasting sessions are available, featuring The Landing wines alongside an extensive local and international offering.

ACTIVITIES:

The Landing comprises a thousand acres of land. The private beaches are perfect for picnicking, fishing and watersports, with complimentary use of The Landing's kayaks and paddleboards. In addition, The Landing's boat Iti Rangi is available for local fishing and sight seeing, and larger charter fishing excursions can easily be arranged. Other on-site activities include eight different walking tracks, mountain biking, guided kiwi-spotting and complimentary use of The Landing's comprehensive gym.

Local, off-site activities that can be arranged include jet skiing, scuba diving, swimming with dolphins, mountain biking the twin Coast Cycle Trail, golf, horse trekking and the historic Waitangi Treaty Grounds and museum.
